Commitments expected from our suppliers

Human Rights

We uphold human rights as outlined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations. We maintain a zero-tolerance policy towards child labor, forced labor, or any other form of exploitation.

Labor standards

AS Industries requires its suppliers to adhere to all applicable labor laws in their respective countries of operation and commit to upholding the principles outlined in the following international conventions:

- International Labour Organization (ILO) Convention 14, ensuring a minimum of twenty-four consecutive hours of weekly rest.
- ILO Conventions 29 and 105, prohibiting the use of forced labor.
- ILO Conventions addressing the prohibition of child labor and establishing minimum working ages.

Furthermore, AS Industries suppliers must adhere to the following requirements:

- Avoid engaging in illegal employment practices.
- Ensure equal professional opportunities and fair treatment of workers, without discrimination based on ethnic origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, personal political beliefs, or religion.
- Provide a safe and healthy working environment for their employees.
- Foster the development of social dialogue within the workplace.

By adhering to these standards, AS Industries and its suppliers contribute to promoting ethical labor practices and safeguarding the well-being of workers worldwide.

Environment

AS Industries suppliers are required to implement the following measures:

- Ensure compliance with all relevant environmental laws and regulations.
- Minimize their operational environmental footprint by reducing waste production and energy consumption.
- Encourage employee engagement in the supplier's environmental policies and practices.

Corporate Governance

Suppliers and subcontractors must uphold the intellectual property rights, industrial and commercial secrets, as well as any other confidential, proprietary, or sensitive information of AS Industries, and are prohibited from unauthorized use. AS Industries expects all its suppliers to enforce policies that ensure strict compliance with the confidentiality of such information. Suppliers and subcontractors are obligated to adhere to current regulations regarding the collection and use of personal data of AS Industries' employees or customers.
